



Norbert Hübner, MD

Norbert Hübner is currently Professor and Chair of Cardiovascular and Metabolic Sciences at the Charité Medical School Berlin, Germany and heads a programme on Medical Genomics and Genetics at the Max-Delbruck-Center for Molecular Medicine (MDC).

Prof. Dr. Hübner studied Medicine in Heidelberg and Berlin and carried out his doctoral thesis work at the Department of Cardiology, Children's Hospital, Boston that led to his doctorate degree from the Freie University Berlin, Germany. He subsequently carried out his postdoctoral work with Detlev Ganten at the Max-Delbruck-Center for Molecular Medicine (MDC), Berlin.

In 2004 Prof. Dr. Hübner became Assistant Professor and started his own lab. His laboratory uses large-scale technologies and systems biology approaches to identify genes, gene networks, and genomic mechanisms underlying common cardiovascular and metabolic diseases.
